ADRA has a goal to see each NZ church actively serving in the community. The ADRA Church Partnership Programme is our way of helping this goal become reality. The Church Partnership Program (CPP) is a three-way partnership between The Adventist Development & Relief Agency, The Conferences of the Seventh-day Adventist Church in New Zealand and your local church. The CPP includes a series of programmes that have been selected as suitable and effective methods for a church to work within their local community. These programmes have been designed specifically for local churches, taking into account the needs of urban, rural and Maori and Pasifika families.

The programmes your local church can offer through the CPP include:

- **'My Money'**, a family budgeting programme that empowers families with the knowledge and confidence they need to get their finances under control.
- **'Welcome Baby'**, a baby clothing library programme that provides new clothing, food and support to new babies and their families.
- **'Toolbox'**, a parenting workshop programme offering in partnership with one of NZ's biggest providers of parent education, The Parenting Place.
- **'Pathways'**, a life skills development programme which focuses on helping people gain the knowledge and skills to obtain their licence.
- **'BeSomebody2Someone'**, a youth mentoring programme which aims to help young people navigate their youth safely and become adults that contribute positively to the world.
- Plus, an innovations fund which allows churches to trial new ideas in their community. If these programmes are not enough, there is also the Innovations Fund, to support initiatives focused on family wellbeing and community development.
