Connected

- 3. Support the school to grow connection with ADRA's purpose.
- 4. Lead and organize an ADRA fundraiser at your school to raise money for a chosen project.
- 5. Engage in regular communication between ADRA and other Ambassadors via occasional zoom meetings, phone calls and social media.

Courageous

- 6. Proactively share about ADRA among peers, family & peers, e.g. Termly presentations @ school chapel, ADRA notice in School Newsletter, ADRA notice board at school, etc.
- 7. Engage in networking and review of Ambassador Initiative.
- 8. Represent School in discussions with ADRA leaders.
- 9. Develop and share new ideas for raising awareness and donor support for ADRA.
