Benefits of a Will

We understand that making a Will is a sensitive and personal process. Yet it is a crucial element in making sure that your wishes are known and carried out, and that your loved ones and the causes that you care about are looked after well into the future. Whether you have few possessions or many, you should have a Will, as without it, your estate will usually be settled according to legislation and your wishes may not be met. If you already have a Will, remember to update it regularly in order to ensure that it reflects your wishes—especially if your circumstances change.





Preparing Your Will

The first step is to discuss your intentions with your family and loved ones. Once you have done this, meet with your solicitor or trust officer for professional advice.

If you decide to include ADRA in your Will, we offer some suggested wording to help your solicitor or trust officer in writing up your wishes.

Recommended wording:

"To Adventist Development and Relief Agency, an Incorporated Charitable Trust in New Zealand, of 124 Pah Road, Royal Oak, Auckland, New Zealand to be applied under the direction of its Board of Directors for its charitable purposes (in the strict legal sense)."

A Future Free From Disease

For over forty years, underground wells were the closest source of water for David's village in Vanuatu. The wells, along with other far away water sources, carried mud and disease. With no other options available to them, many people got sick and even died as a result of drinking the contaminated water. As an older man in his village, David has witnessed the loss of many of his friends as he grew up as a consequence of the unclean water. He was one of the lucky ones, "Most of my mates who first settled with me, have died from it [the unclean water]," David shared.

Since then, ADRA has built tap stands in David's village to provide clean and safe water. Along with this, ADRA has built latrines and hosted workshops promoting safe hygiene practices in his community.

"I am so happy and proud... to witness this huge miracle of the new water supply project into our village" shared David with tears in his eyes. Despite the loss of life he's witnessed David is hopeful for the future of his village. His children and grandchildren will not have to experience that same hardship and can instead have a thriving future free from water-borne diseases.

They will not miss as much school through being sick all the time, and will grow happy and healthier, and have more opportunities for the future.

Through this project, ADRA was able to shape the futures of the next generation and leave a legacy of hope. You can do the same.
